Alphabet Chart

Number Chart

We will practice counting and number recognition throughout the year. By April 2021, we expect your child to count, recognize and write their numbers from 1- 120.

Reading Log

Each month you will receive a Reading Log. We included September and October. Each night you read to your child they must color in one of the dated pictures. When your child returns to school in October (Fingers Crossed), the October sheet should be placed in their Homework Folder. This stays in their Homework folder. Sight Word List

Your child will learn many high frequency words this school year. We call these "**Popcorn Words**". Sight word list "1" and "2" are included for review at home. We will let you know what words we are practicing for the week. **At home practice is beneficial and highly recommended. If you want your child to learn to read ... Learning Their Sight Words is Key.**

Please have your child reference this chart when they are working on letter sounds and writing.



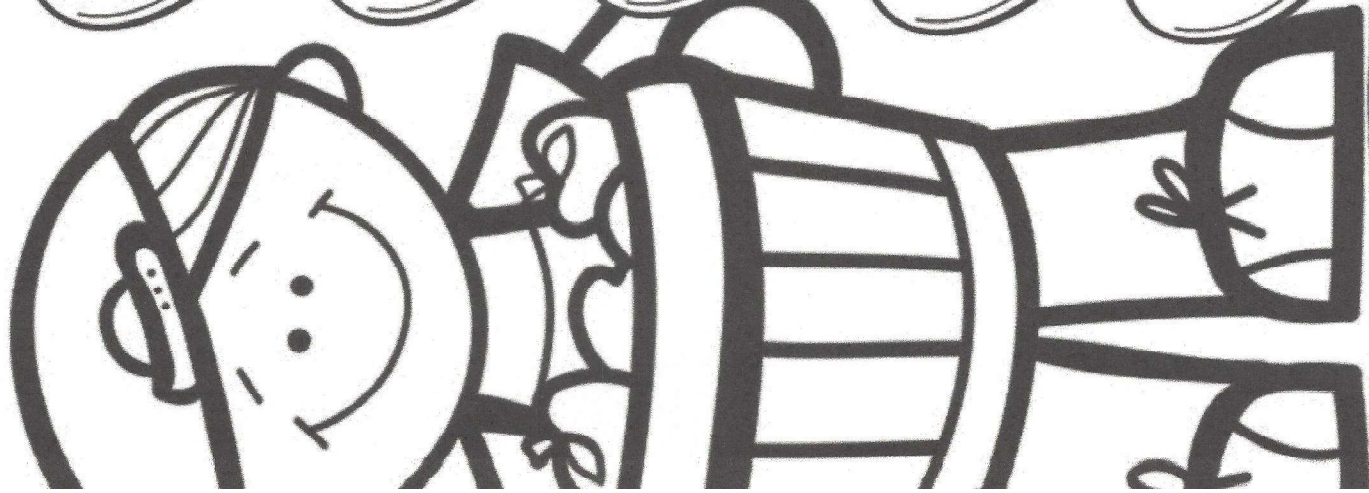
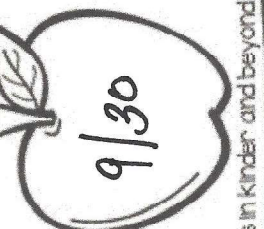
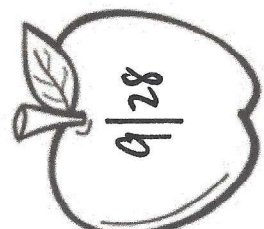
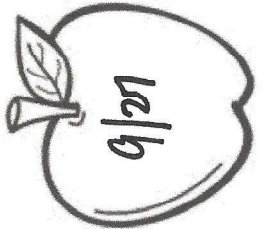
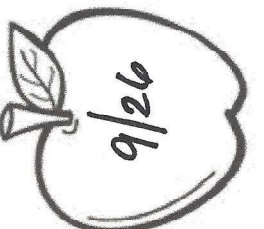
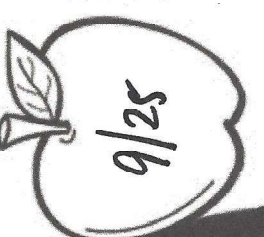
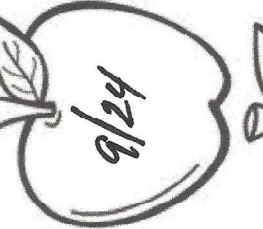
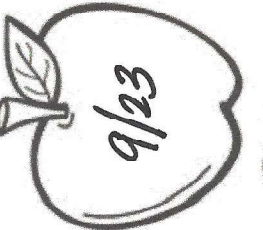
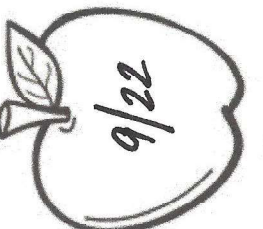
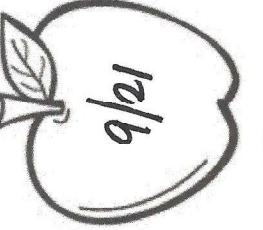
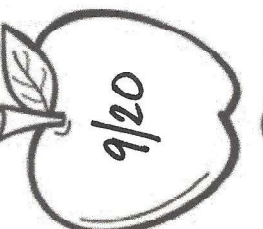
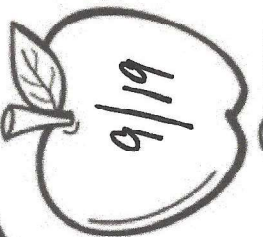
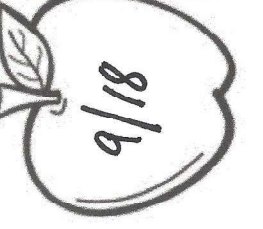
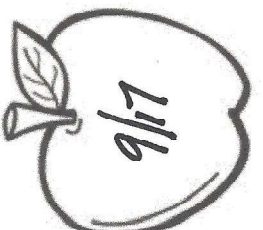
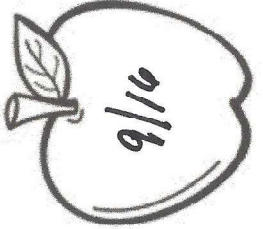
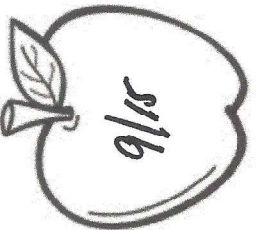
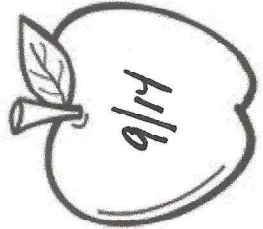
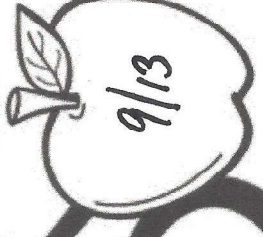
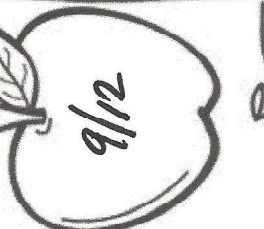
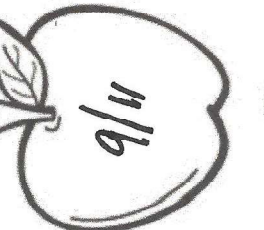
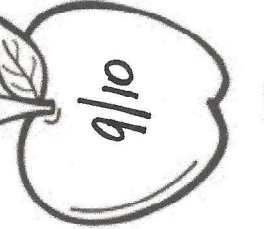
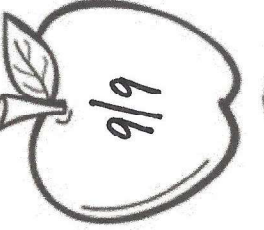
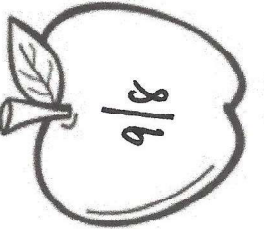
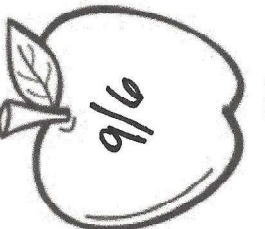
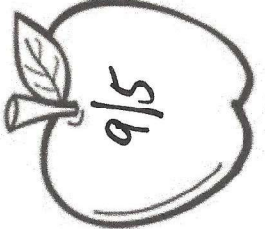
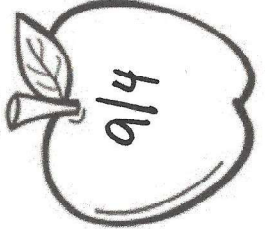
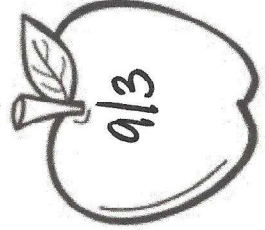
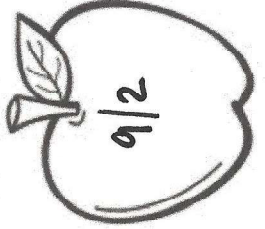
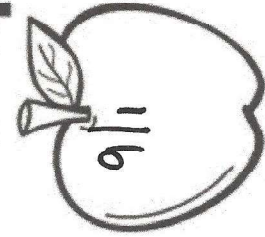
