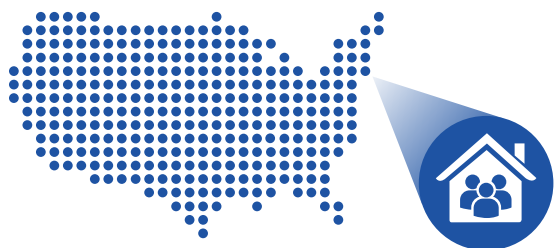

The census counts people of all ages, including visitors, foster children, and people not born in the US. No matter what your household looks like, count everybody.

determines:



Our share of billions of dollars for our schools.



The resources allocated to every school, based on how many students are counted in the area.



The size and shape of school districts.
